LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT/CEO



"A child who is not embraced by the village, will burn it down to feel its warmth" - African Proverb

This year we have intentionally turned our focus to embracing the children at the bottom of every category in public schools districts with the exception of discipline.

Black children are pushed out of school at higher rates than their counterparts and it appears that no one is too concerned. COVID wreaked havoc in our communities and children were forced to shutdown and disconnect from everything that was familiar. Many had no outlet and frustrations boiled over. Schools opened without a plan of how to service students where they were currently, and resumed old habits of suspending and expelling because they lacked the will and training to meet students where they are now. Our team of Youth Mental Health First Aid trained individuals descended into schools where we were needed the most.

Our team is unapologetic and tenacious when it comes to protecting children and making sure they are being treated fairly with respect and that their dignity remains in tact. We have worked with multiple Districts and their leadership teams waging both private and public battles against all those who have aimed to disregard our children. We have shown up on campuses, in District offices, attended school board meetings all while making sure all of our regular programming remained functioning at its highest levels. We have seen tremendous growth and a new endeavor is on the horizon. #TeamBYLP is expanding and I cannot wait to see what 2023 brings.






